

Arizona Demographics (2016)*

- ❖ Total foreign born population – 934,883
- ❖ 13.5% of the state’s 7 million people are foreign born
 - 42.7% naturalized citizens
 - ≈27.8% lawful permanent residents

 - ≈29.5% undocumented and temporary status
- ❖ 42.5% rise in immigrant population from 2000 to 2016
- ❖ 28.9% of children in the state under age 18 have 1 or more immigrant parents
 - 90.2% of children with immigrant parents in the state are U.S. native.
