- ❖ Total foreign born population – 1,038,312
- ❖ 10.1% of the state's people 10 million people are foreign born
 - 41.1% naturalized citizens
 - 25% lawful permanent residents or temporary legal status
 - 33.8% undocumented immigrants

- ❖ 79.9% rise in immigrant population from 2000-2016
- ❖ 20.7% of children in the state under age 18 have 1 or more immigrant parents
