

# Hawaii Demographics (2016)\*

- ❖ Total foreign born population – 262,485
  - ❖ 18.4% of the state's 1.5 million people are foreign born
    - 56.9% naturalized citizens
    - ≈35.1% lawful permanent residents and temporary status
    - ≈8% undocumented

- ❖ 23.7% rise in immigrant population from 2000 to 2016
  - ❖ 29.8% of children in the state under age 18 have 1 or more immigrant parents
    - 86.9% of children with immigrant parents in the state are U.S. native.

- ▶ Asia – 78.8%
  - ▶ Philippines (46%)
  - ▶ Japan (9.3%)
  - ▶ China (9.2%)
  - ▶ Korea (6.4%)
  - ▶ Vietnam (2.2%)
- ▶ Oceania – 10.9%
- ▶ Latin America – 4.6%
  - ▶ Mexico (2.0%)
  - ▶ South America (1.6%)
- ▶ Europe – 3.7%

## Limited English Proficiency

(Speak English less than very well)

- ▶ Naturalized citizens 43.7%
- ▶ Non-citizens 61.6%
