

Indiana Demographics (2013)*

- ❖ Total foreign born population – 314,501
- ❖ 4.8% of the state's 6.5 people is foreign born
 - 35.2% naturalized citizens
 - ~62.1%[^] legal permanent residents and temporary visa holders (2012 data)
 - ~1.8%[^] undocumented (Immigration Policy Center 2012 data)
- ❖ 68.6% rise in immigrant population from 2000 to 2013
- ❖ High proportion of new immigrants
 - 22.5% entered in the 1990s
 - 54.5% entered 2000 or later
- ❖ 9.7% of children in the state under age 18 have one or more immigrant parents
 - 85.5% of these children are native-born U.S. citizens
