 - 35.2% naturalized citizens
 - ~62.1%^ legal permanent residents and temporary visa holders (2012 data)
 - ~1.8%^ undocumented (Immigration Policy Center 2012 data)
- * 68.6% rise in immigrant population from 2000 to 2013
- * High proportion of new immigrants
 - 22.5% entered in the 1990s
 - 54.5% entered 2000 or later
- * 9.7% of children in the state under age 18 have one or more immigrant parents
 - $_{\circ}$ 85.5% of these children are native-born U.S. citizens
