

Maryland Demographics (2016)*

- ❖ Total foreign born population – 921,870
- ❖ 15.3% of the state's 6 million people are foreign born
 - 50.8% naturalized citizens
 - ≈27.1% lawful permanent residents

 - ≈22.1% undocumented and temporary status
- ❖ 77.9% rise in immigrant population from 2000 to 2016
- ❖ 28.3% of children in the state under age 18 have 1 or more immigrant parents
 - 85.9% of children with immigrant parents in the state are U.S. native.
