

# Nevada Demographics (2016)\*

- ❖ Total foreign born population – 586,799
- ❖ 20% of the state's 3 million people are foreign born
  - 47.5% naturalized citizens
  - ≈22.2% lawful permanent residents

  - ≈30.4% undocumented and temporary status
- ❖ 85.4% rise in immigrant population from 2000 to 2016
- ❖ 39.3% of children in the state under age 18 have 1 or more immigrant parents
  - 90.1% of children with immigrant parents in the state are U.S. native.

  - ▶ Germany (1.3%)
  - ▶ Eastern Europe (2.9%)
- ▶ Africa – 3.1%
