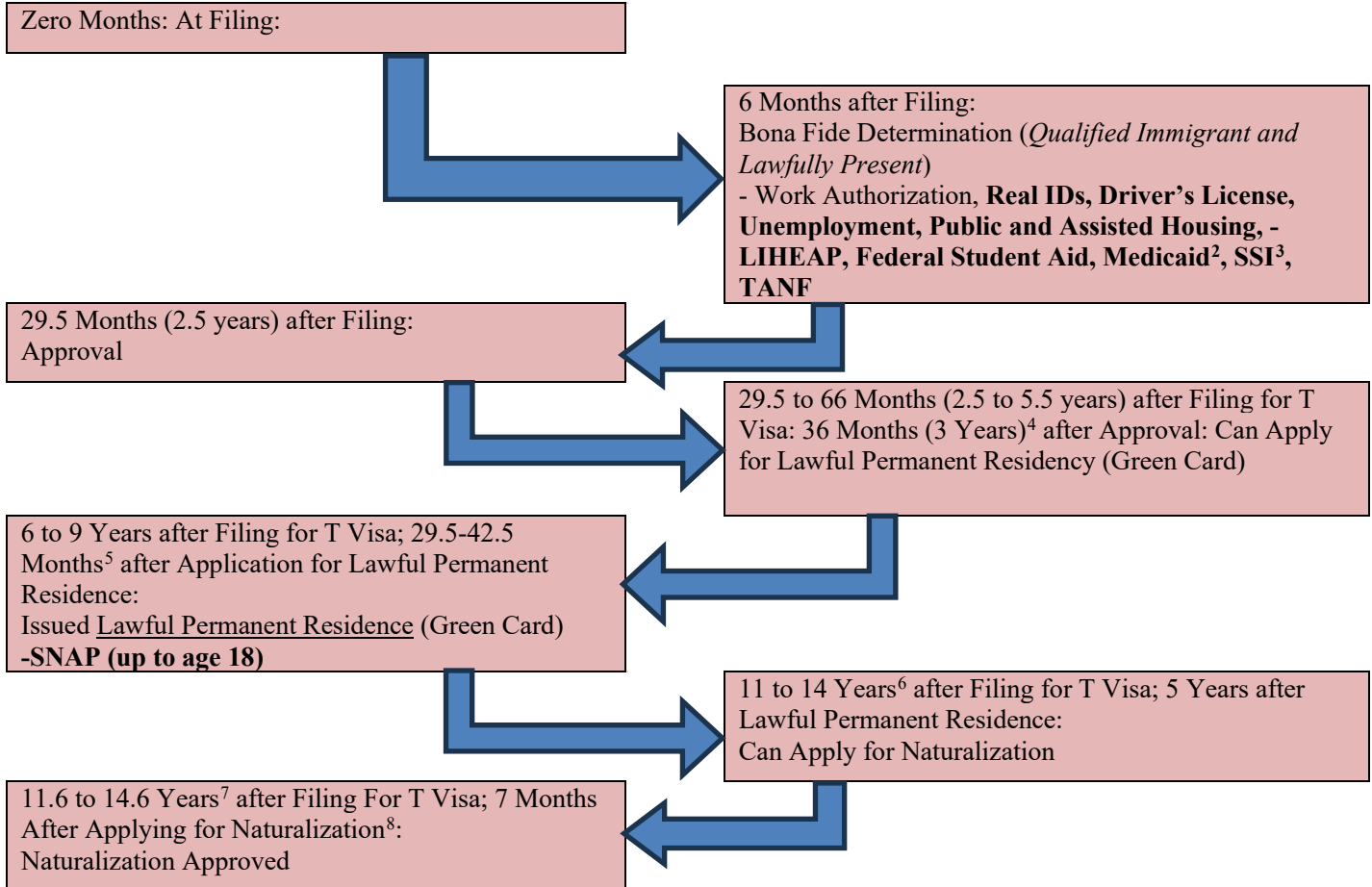

T Visa Children¹

- Prenatal care from conception through the last day of the month in which the 60-day postpartum period ends is open to all persons with incomes at or under 312%FPI without regard to immigration status.
- All children are eligible for K-12 public education regardless of immigration status



*State funded available prior to meeting federal: 5-year bar, 40 quarters, and/or lawful permanent residence requirements.

T Visa Adults

- Work Authorization, **Real IDs, Driver's License, Unemployment, Public and Assisted Housing, - LIHEAP, Federal Student Aid, Medicaid⁹, SSI¹⁰, TANF**

29.5 Months (2.5 years) after Filing:
Approval

29.5 to 66 Months (2.5 to 5.5 years) after Filing for T Visa: 36 Months (3 Years)¹¹ after Approval:
Can Apply for Lawful Permanent Residence (Green Card)

6.0 to 9.0 Years after Filing for T Visa; 29.5-42.5 Months¹² after Filing for T Visa; 42.5 Months after Application for Lawful Permanent Residence:
Issued Lawful Permanent Residence (Green Card) -SNAP¹³

11.0 to 14.0 Years¹⁴ after Filing for T Visa; 5 Years after Lawful Permanent Residence:
Can Apply for Naturalization

11.6 to 14.6 Years¹⁵ after Filing For T Visa; 7 Months After Applying for Naturalization¹⁶:
Naturalization Approved
