

Protection and Legal Affairs



Mexican IDs

People get their documents the same day of their appointment.

Passports

- We do have emergency appointments for people with a Notice to Appear or time sensitive cases.
- Minors: we request signature of both custodial parents, but we can evaluate specific cases when one or both parent are missing.
 - OP7 for signature in other parts of the world.

Consular ID Cards

- Mexican ID with the individuals address in the United States.
- Mexican Voting Credential.

Birth Certificate

- Registry of Mexican nationals, whether it is by birth or descent nationality.
- Gender Identity Recognition.

Emergency Travel Document

- For people who are unable to provide passport requirements, usually seeking to go back to Mexico.

NGOs and Advocates Referrals

Shelters; domestic and gender violence prevention; family orientation; support groups; and emergency referrals.

Family Law and Gender Issues

Financial aid or humanitarian assistance (if applicable); repatriation and family reunification support.

Legal Advice and Referrals

Guidance for individuals eligible for immigration reliefs such as VAWA, T, or U visa; civil and criminal law.





Free Legal Advice and Assistance

Legal screenings

Free sessions with attorneys from allied firms and NGOs, across all areas of law. These sessions are offered three to four times a month.

PALE

The Legal External Assistance Program, established through direct contracts with law firms, attorneys, and NGOs, provides financial assistance to Mexican nationals who require funds to access legal representation, in particular cases.
