## Colorado (2021)\*

- Total foreign-born population 520,273
- 9.8% of the state's  $\sim 5.8$  million people are foreign born
  - 49% naturalized citizens
  - 31% legal permanent residents (as of 2019)
  - 20% temporary visa holders or undocumented immigrants
- 54.2% rise in immigrant population from 2000 to 2021

\*Length of time immigrants have lived in the U.S.

- 43.3% entered before 1999
- 27.7% entered 2000 2009
- **29.1% since 2010**
- 22.2% of children under age 18 have one or more immigrant parents
  - $_{\circ}~$  89.1% of these children are native-born U.S. citizens
