## Washington (2021)\*

- Total foreign-born population 1,143,311
- ✤ 14.8% of the state's ~ 7.7 million people are foreign born
  - $_{\circ}$  49% naturalized citizens
  - 28% legal permanent residents (as of 2019)
  - 23% temporary visa holders or undocumented immigrants
- $_{\circ}$   $\,$  86.1% rise in immigrant population from 2000 to 2021  $\,$
- Length of time immigrants have lived in the U.S.
  - 42.2% entered before 1999
  - 24.8% entered 2000 2009
  - $_{\circ}~$  33% since 2010
- 31.1% of children under age 18 have one or more immigrant parents
  - $_{\circ}~$  88.1% of these children are native-born U.S. citizens
