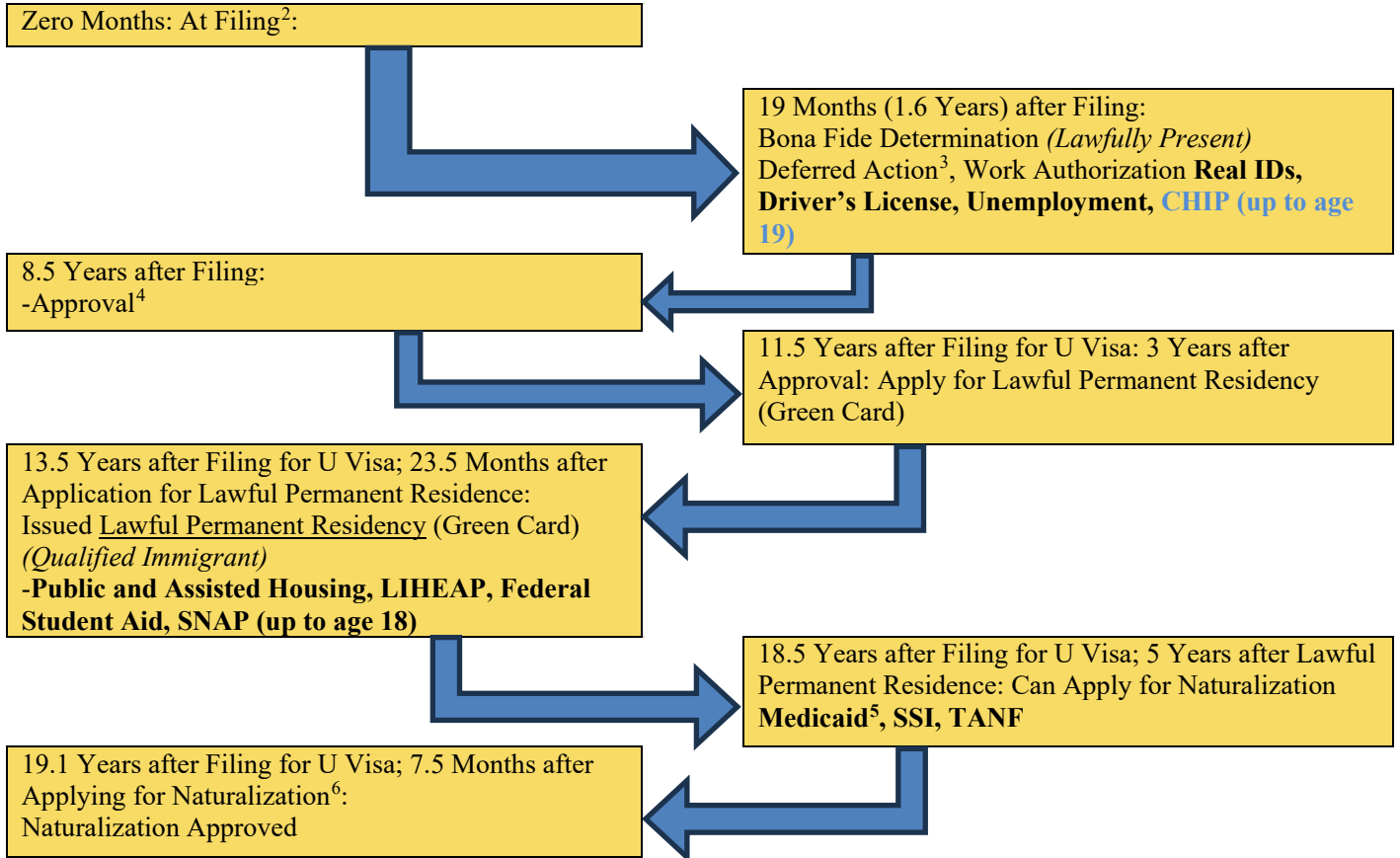

U Visa Children¹

- Kentucky provides state-funded healthcare for lawfully present children.
- Kentucky grants in-state tuition and institutional aid or scholarships to eligible Kentucky residents who graduated from a high school in the state.
- All children are eligible for K-12 public education regardless of immigration status



*State funded available prior to meeting federal: 5-year bar, 40 quarters, and lawful permanent residence requirements.

U Visa Adults

- Kentucky provides state-funded healthcare for lawfully present children.
- Kentucky grants in-state tuition and institutional aid or scholarships to eligible Kentucky residents who graduated from a high school in the state.

Zero Months: At Filing⁷:

19 Months (1.6 Years) after Filing:
Bona Fide Determination (*Lawfully Present*)
Deferred Action⁸, Work Authorization **Real IDs**,
Driver's License, **Unemployment**, **CHIP (if pregnant)**

8.5 Years after Filing:
-Approval⁹

11.5 Years after Filing for U Visa: 3 Years after Approval:
Apply for Lawful Permanent Residency (Green Card)

13.5 Years after Filing for U Visa; 23.5 Months after Application for Lawful Permanent Residency:
Issued Lawful Permanent Residency (Green Card) (*Qualified Immigrant*)
-**Public and Assisted Housing**, **LIHEAP**, **Federal Student Aid**, **SNAP**¹⁰

18.5 Years after Filing for U Visa; 5 Years after Lawful Permanent Residency:
Medicaid¹¹, **SSI**, **TANF**
Can Apply for Naturalization

19.1 Years after Filing for U Visa; 7.5 Months after Applying for Naturalization¹²:
Naturalization Approved
