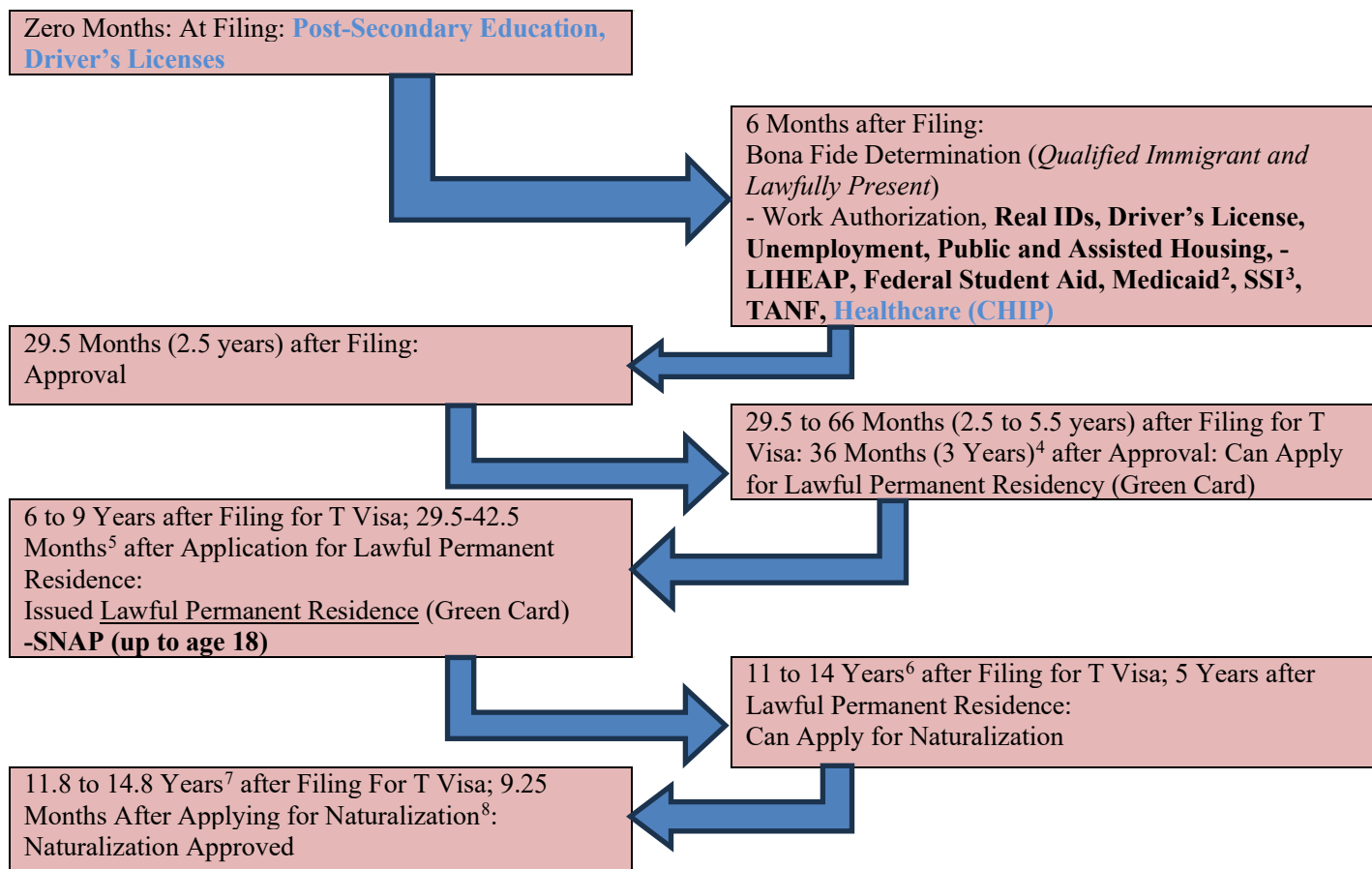


Nevada Benefits Infographic – T Visa,

T Visa Children¹

- All students eligible for in-state tuition and financial aid at public postsecondary institutions regardless of immigration status if the student graduated or has GED from Nevada high school or the student or their parent resided in the state for 12 months.
- Nevada driver's license, professional and occupational licenses available to all persons without regard to immigration status for Nevada residents
- All children are eligible for K-12 public education regardless of immigration status



*State funded available prior to meeting federal: 5-year bar, 40 quarters, and/or lawful permanent residence requirements.

T Visa Adults

Zero Months: At Filing: **Post-Secondary Education, Driver's Licenses**

6 Months after Filing:
Bona Fide Determination (*Qualified Immigrant and Lawfully Present*)

- Work Authorization, **Real IDs, Driver's License, Unemployment, Public and Assisted Housing, - LIHEAP, Federal Student Aid, Medicaid⁹, SSI¹⁰, TANF**

29.5 Months (2.5 years) after Filing:
Approval

29.5 to 66 Months (2.5 to 5.5 years) after Filing for T Visa: 36 Months (3 Years)¹¹ after Approval:
Can Apply for Lawful Permanent Residency (Green Card)

6.0 to 9.0 Years after Filing for T Visa; 29.5-42.5 Months¹² after Filing for T Visa; 42.5 Months after Application for Lawful Permanent Residence:
Issued Lawful Permanent Residency (Green Card) -SNAP¹³

11.0 to 14.0 Years¹⁴ after Filing for T Visa; 5 Years after Lawful Permanent Residence:
Can Apply for Naturalization

11.8 to 14.8 Years¹⁵ after Filing For T Visa; 9.25 Months After Applying for Naturalization¹⁶:
Naturalization Approved
