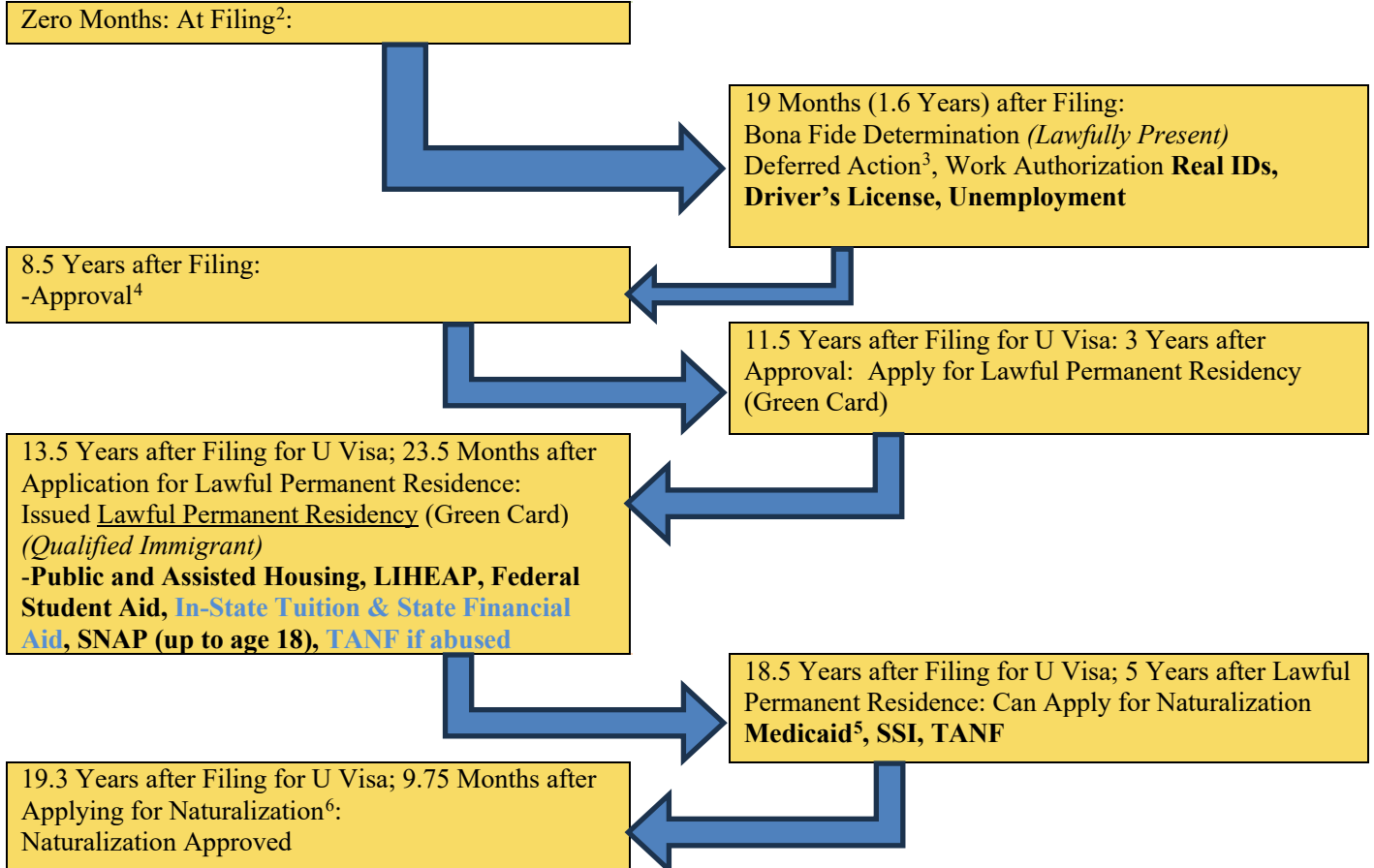

## U Visa Children<sup>1</sup>

- All pregnant person is eligible for prenatal care, delivery 60 days postpartum care and health insurance available through CoverKids Pregnant Women Program.
- All children are eligible for K-12 public education regardless of immigration status.



\*State funded available prior to meeting federal: 5-year bar, 40 quarters, and lawful permanent residence requirements.

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## U Visa Adults

- All pregnant person is eligible for prenatal care, delivery 60 days postpartum care and health insurance available through CoverKids Pregnant Women Program.

Zero Months: At Filing<sup>7</sup>:

19 Months (1.6 Years) after Filing:  
Bona Fide Determination (*Lawfully Present*)  
Deferred Action<sup>8</sup>, Work Authorization **Real IDs**,  
**Driver's License, Unemployment**

8.5 Years after Filing:

11.5 Years after Filing for U Visa: 3 Years after  
Approval:  
Apply for Lawful Permanent Residence (Green  
Card)

13.5 Years after Filing for U Visa; 23.5 Months  
after Application for Lawful Permanent Residence:  
Issued Lawful Permanent Residence (Green Card)  
(*Qualified Immigrant*)  
-Public and Assisted Housing, LIHEAP, Federal  
Student Aid, **In-State Tuition & State Financial  
Aid, SNAP<sup>10</sup>, TANF if abused**

18.5 Years after Filing for U Visa; 5 Years after  
Lawful Permanent Residence:  
**Medicaid<sup>11</sup>, SSI, TANF**  
Can Apply for Naturalization

19.3 Years after Filing for U Visa; 9.75 Months  
after Applying for Naturalization<sup>12</sup>:
