# **North Dakota Demographics**

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## North Dakota (2021)\*

- Total foreign-born population 33,824
- 4.4% of the state's  $\sim$  775 thousand people are foreign born citizens
  - $_{\circ}$  48.3% naturalized
  - 31% legal permanent residents (as of 2019)
  - $_{\circ}$  20.7% temporary visa holders or undocumented immigrants
- $_{\odot}$  ~179.2% rise in immigrant population from 2000 to 2021
- Length of time immigrants have lived in the U.S.
  - $\circ$  21.9% entered before 1999
  - 24% entered 2000 2009
  - $\circ$  54.1% since 2010
- ✤ 9.5% of children under age 18 have one or more immigrant parents
  - 86.4% of these children are native-born U.S. citizens
